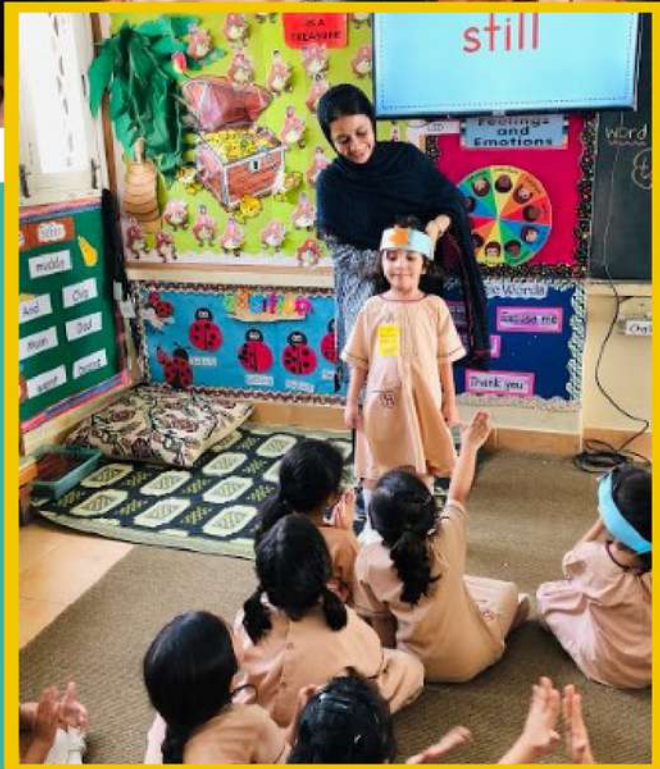
Teachers' Day
