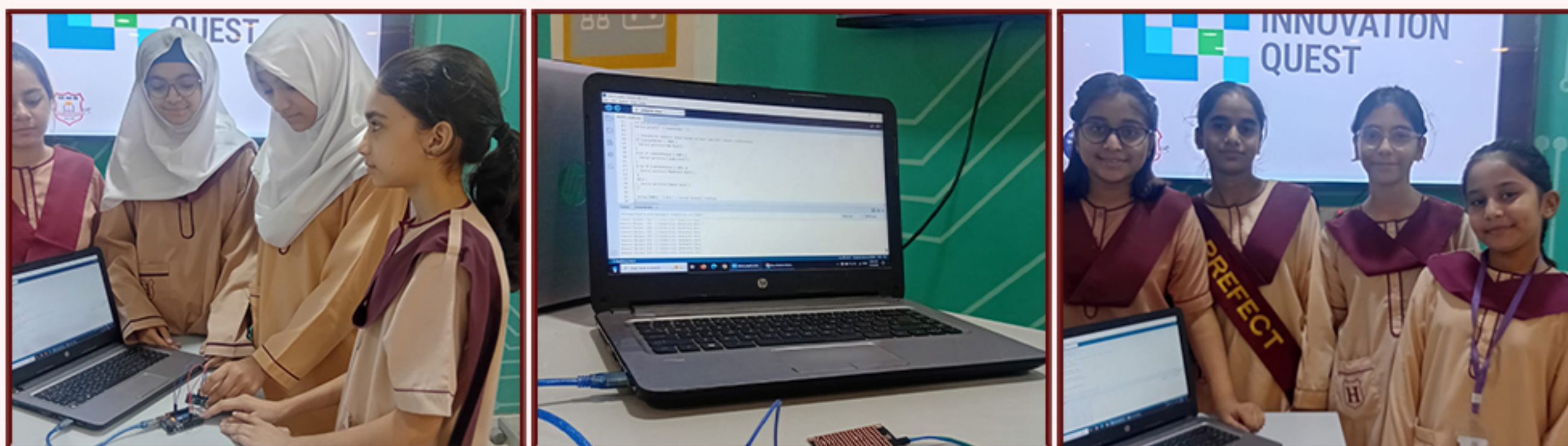
GRADE V EXTRA CURRICULAR: DISCOVER, EXPLORE & GROW!

MERI SEHAT

ROBOTMEA EDUTECH

At the start of the 2026–27 academic year, Habib Girls' School entered into a strategic partnership with Robotmea Edutech to establish Discovery and Innovation Hubs. The collaboration integrates Robotics, Artificial Intelligence (AI), the Internet of Things (IoT), and STEAM learning into the curriculum, helping students develop 21st-century and Industry 4.0 skills while fostering innovation and entrepreneurship. The partnership includes robotic kits and instructional resources, teacher training and workshops, and opportunities for students to participate in local and international robotics competitions.

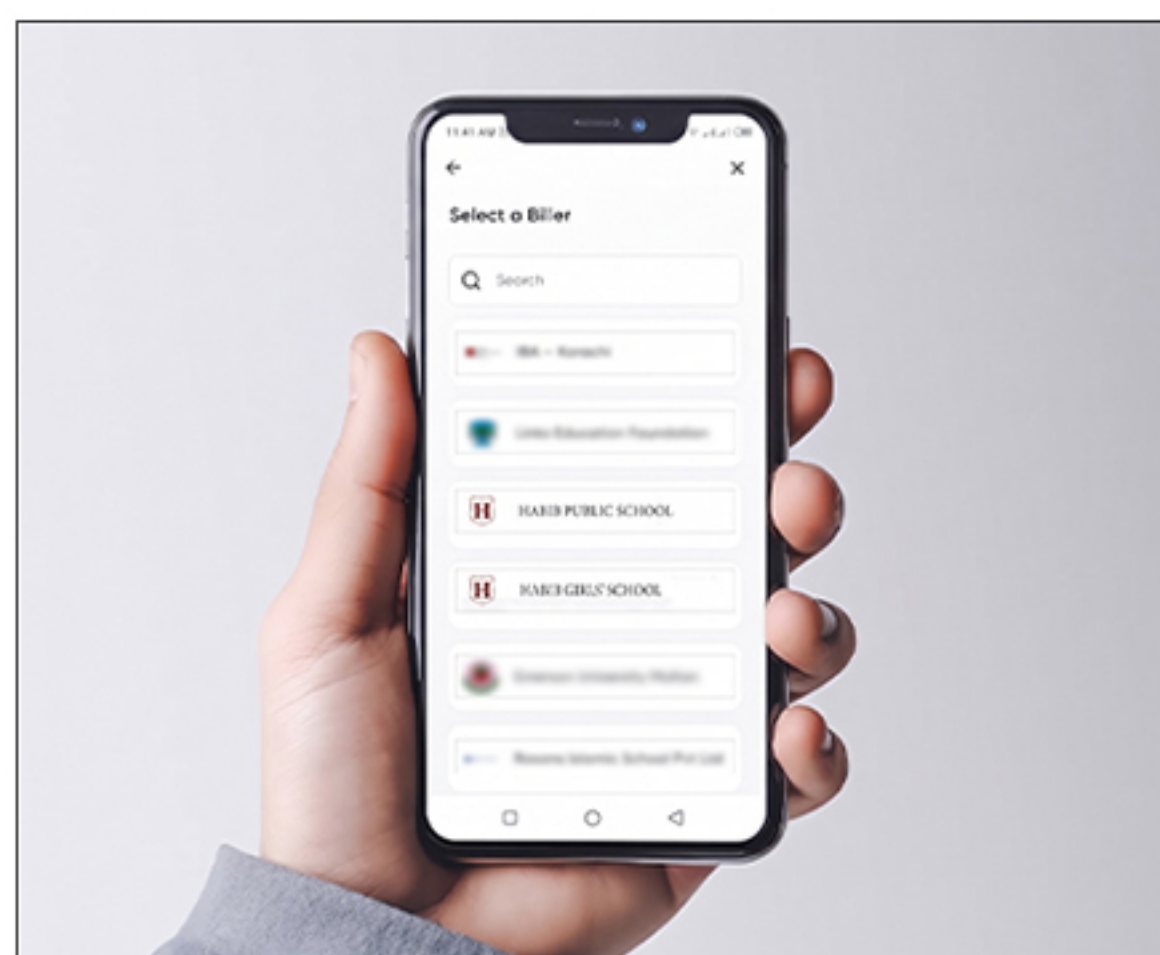
As part of our commitment to digital convenience, our streamlined online banking channel ensures that your transactions are fast, secure, and fully transparent.
