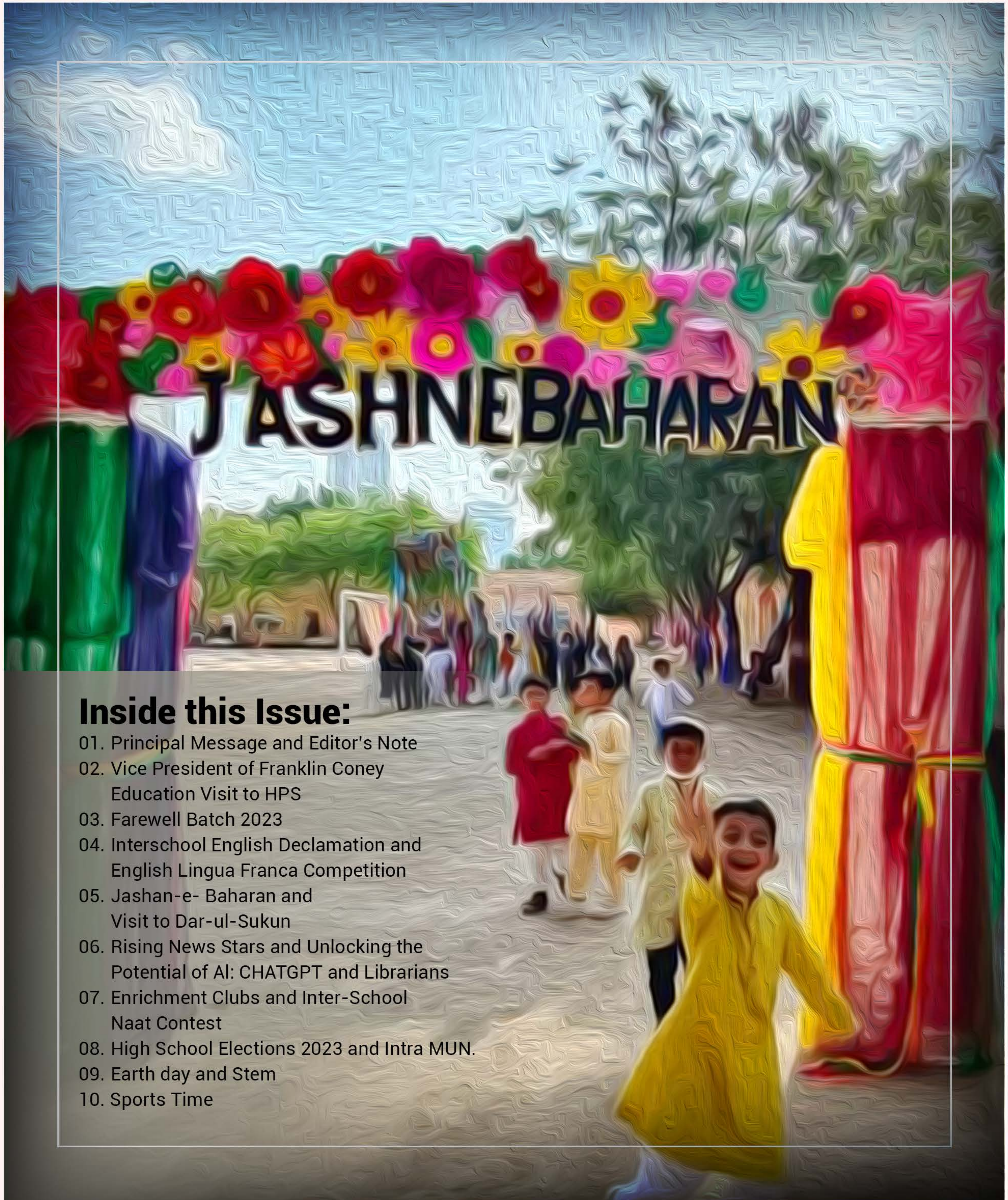

4. Mushabbar Ali Outstanding Diplomat (Representing Farooq Sattar)



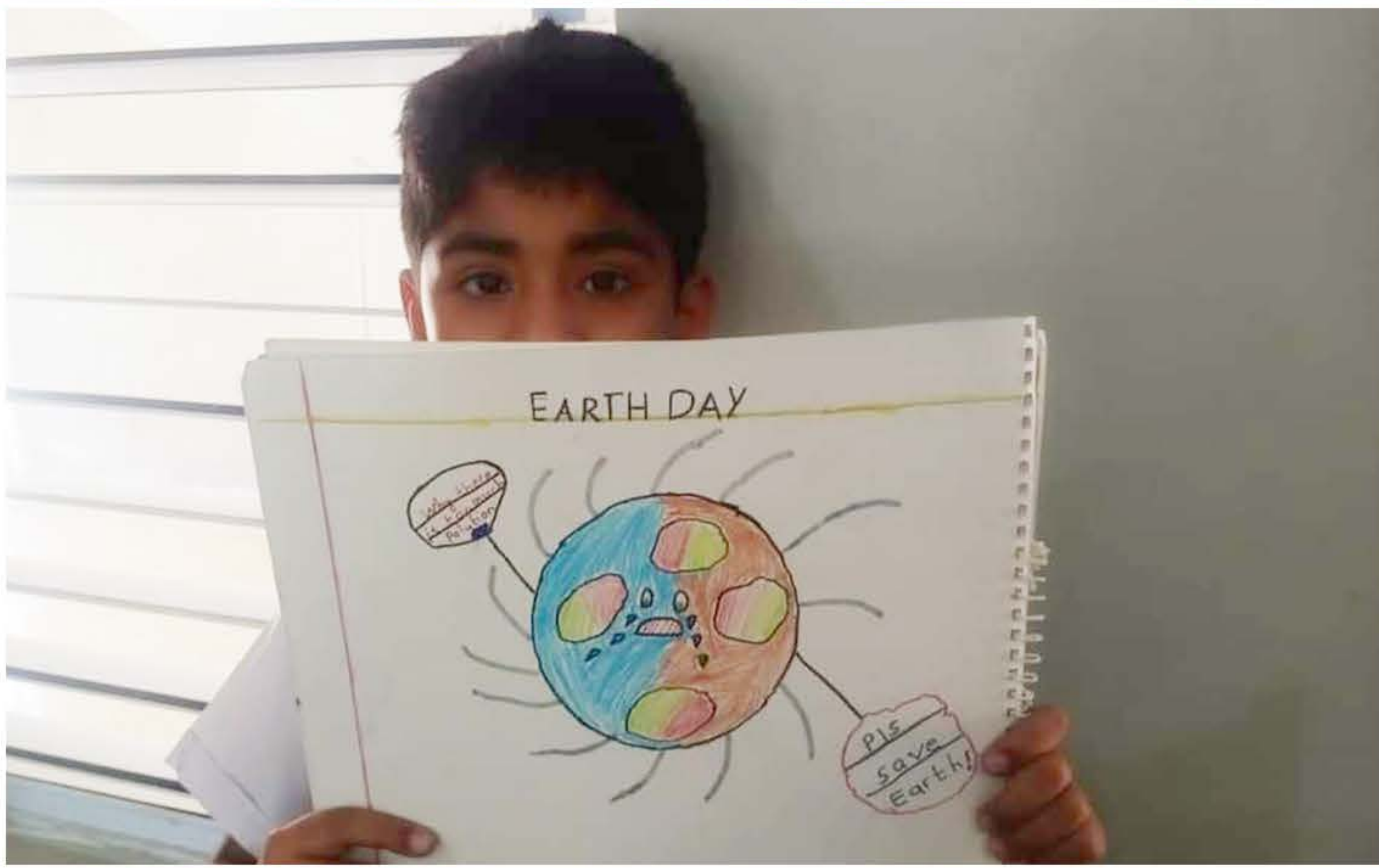
