Words | Candidates will be expected to have developed: <br> familiarity with phonics and spelling of simple words; <br> knowledge of graphemes/phonemes correspondence <br> through identifying and writing initial and final <br> phonemes in words (e.g. fit, pan, mat etc.); <br> recognition of sound and spelling patterns through use <br> of rhyme to identify rhyming words <br> (E.g. hop, top, mop and fat, mat, pat etc.). |

| 2. Sentences | Candidates' understanding of basic rules for grammar <br> and punctuation will be tested through: Use of a <br> capital letter for the start of their own name and at the <br> beginning of a sentence; construction of very simple <br> sentences (e.g. 4-5 words); appreciation that a full <br> stop ends a sentence; recognition of upper case and <br> lower case letters of the alphabet and their sequence; <br> phonological awareness (e.g. sounds of letters and <br> words and be able to read them); knowledge sounds <br> of vowels; formation and reading of three letter <br> words, sight based vocabulary and ability to label <br> pictures. Singular/Plural, Words Opposites. Colors <br> names, Days of the Week. |
