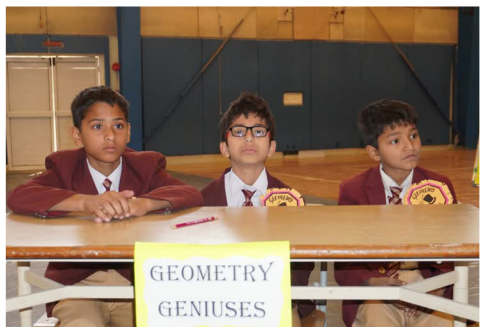
PROGRESS AND FUTURE PLANS
