DUKE OF EDINBURGH'S AWARD PROGRAMME - EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING IN ACTION

LIBRARY CORNER


BARTER BOOK ACTIVITY

SIXTEEN


This book gives helpful advice for teenagers. It encourages us to build confidence, make positive choices, and be ourselves.
