LEADER IN ME

YOUNG LEADERS IN ACTION: 7 HABITS AT WORK

The Leader in Me team recently visited Habib Public School and captured inspiring student reflections on the 7 Habits. LEADERSHIP FORUM

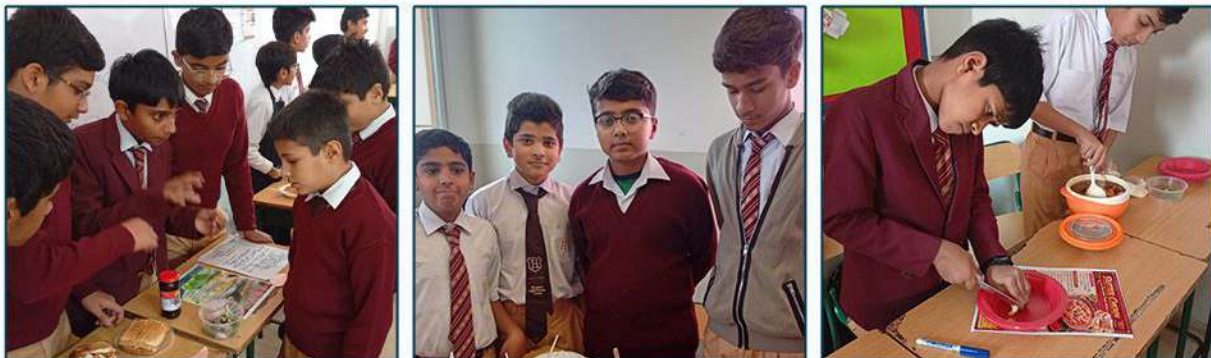
THE THINKING TREE

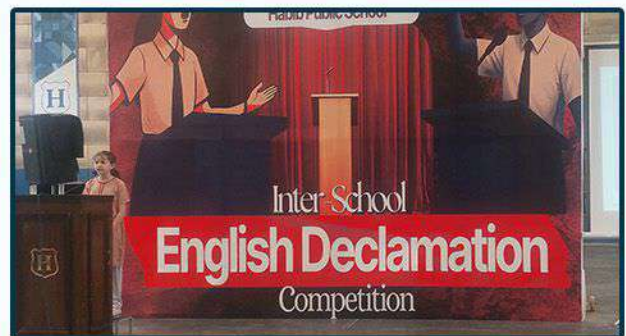

VOICES THAT INSPIRE: ENGLISH DECLAMATION 2026

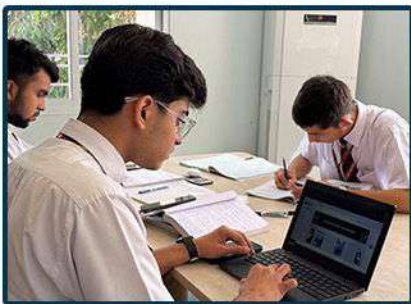

LIBRARY CORNER

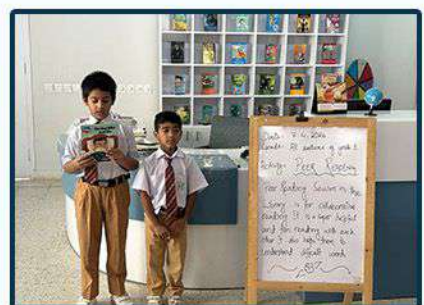
DISCOVER THE BRITISH COUNCIL DIGITAL LIBRARY

EXPLORE OUR MAGAZINE COLLECTION

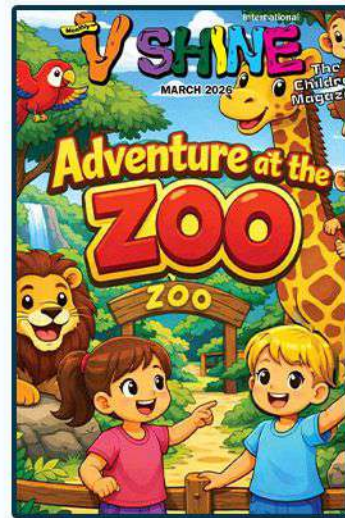
