URDU DECLAMATION CONTEST 2026

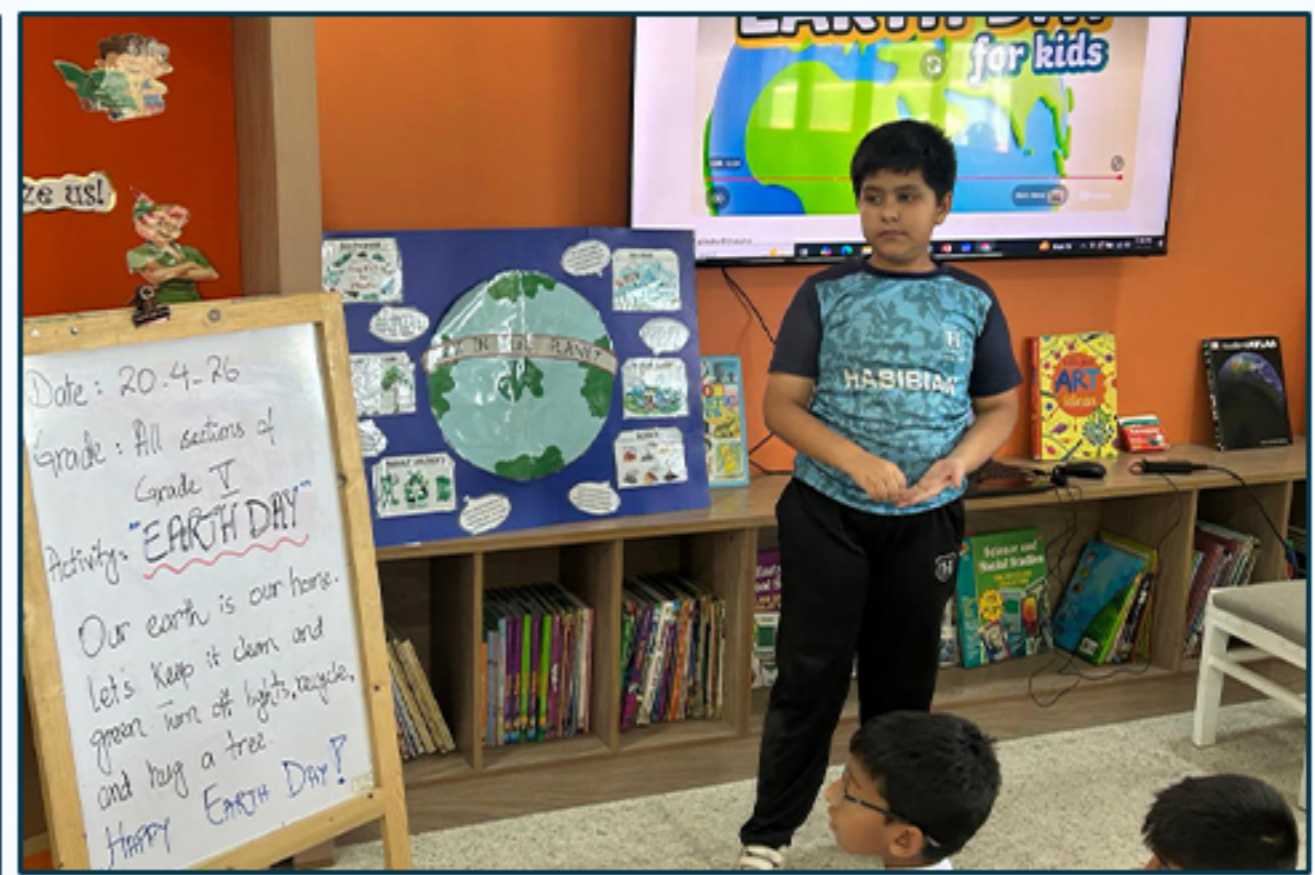
