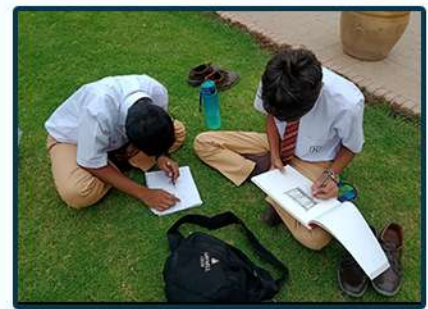
CELEBRATING INDEPENDENCE DAY

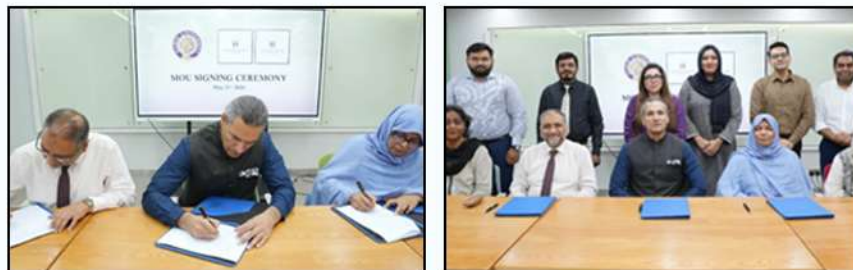
SPELT – STRATEGIC ACADEMIC PARTNERSHIP

HPS SWIMMERS MAKE A SPLASH AT KARACHI CHAMPIONSHIPS

The HPS Swimming Team delivered an outstanding performance at two major swimming championships, bringing home an impressive haul of medals and earning several individual accolades.

At the 1st Lok Sahita Swimming Championship, held at the KMC Sports Complex on 15th and 16th August, our young swimmers showcased exceptional talent and determination. In the U16 category, Abdullah secured an impressive four Gold medals, while the HPS relay teams also earned two Bronze medals in the 4×100m Freestyle and 4×100m Medley Relays. Ali Usman continued his winning streak in the U14 category, securing four Gold medals. In the U10 category, Ibrahim won two Silver and one Bronze medal, while Muaz Amaan earned a Silver medal in the U8 category. M. Farhan Ali added another Silver medal in the U18 category. The team finished the championship with an impressive 8 Gold, 5 Silver and 5 Bronze medals. The success continued at the 2nd Karachi Open Defence Day Boys Age Group Championship, held at Karachi Grammar School on 5th and 6th September. HPS swimmers once again demonstrated their strength across various age categories. Ali Usman was crowned U14 Group Champion, winning an outstanding five Gold medals, while Abdullah became the U16 Group Champion, securing three Gold and two Silver medals. Other notable performances included Muaz Amaan with one Gold and one Silver, Irtiza with two Bronze medals, Ammad with three Bronze medals, Ibrahim with one Silver and one Bronze, Salar with one Bronze, and Farhan Ali with two Bronze medals in the Open category. We proudly congratulate all our swimmers for their dedication, perseverance, and remarkable achievements. 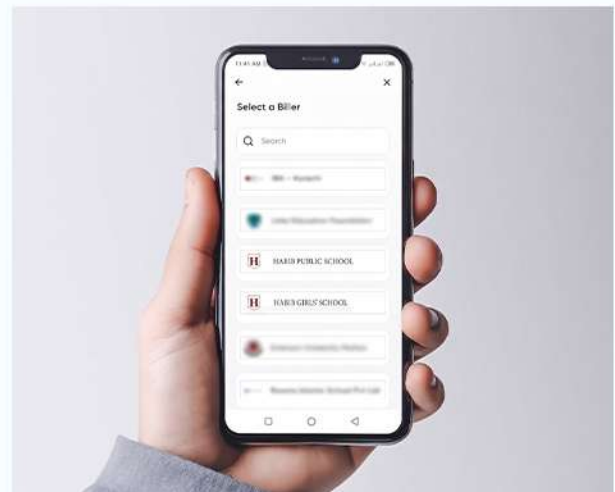
